JOB SEEKER VISA EU BLUE CARD PROGRAM

The job seeker visa for Germany is a Long-Term Residency Permit, which allows you to stay in the country for six months and look for a job. If at the end of the six months you have found a place of employment, you will be given the Germany work visa or a Germany work permit and you will be allowed to work and live there.



Processing Time

3-4 Months



Eligibility Criteria

- **Be of adult age:** - You should be at least 18 to apply for this visa.
- **Have an adequate qualification.**-You are required to have a Bachelor or Master's degree from a German university or other equivalent foreign degrees.
- **Experience requirement.**-You should have a minimum of 5 years of work experience to be eligible for the Germany job seeker visa.
- **Proof of financial stability.**-You should prove you can cover your expenses for the duration of your stay in Germany (720 euro per month).
- Have travel or medical insurance for your entire stay in Germany or until you get your Work Permit.



Key Benefits

- The Germany Job seeker visa is a long-term residence permit that allows you to look for a job for a period of 6 months.
- This visa makes it simpler for you to secure an employment visa as it allows you to attend interviews and find a job in your skilled area of work.
- The Employer will sponsor your Employment Visa under most scenarios; else you will need to do it on your own.
- Visa validity will depend on the employer.

EU Blue Card Program

EU Blue Cards are issued by EU member states to third-country nationals. The holder of an EU Blue Card is entitled to take up residence in the EU for the purpose of taking up gainful employment.



Processing Time

2-3 Months


Eligibility

- You have a German degree, a recognized foreign higher education degree, or you have a foreign higher education degree that is comparable to a German higher education degree.
- You already have a concrete job offer from a company in Germany.
- The position must be appropriate for someone with your qualifications (higher education degree).
- The position in Germany must be remunerated with a gross annual income of at least EUR 56,800 (in 2021). A gross annual salary of at least EUR 44,304 (in 2021) is required for employees in the fields of mathematics, IT, natural sciences, engineering and human medicine. In such cases, the German Federal Employment Agency must approve your request for employment.

Benefits of EU Blue Card

- You will be working in one of the world's best economies.
- You and your family members will have access to the German healthcare and educational system.
- The German Blue Card is issued for 1-4 years and can be renewed.
- After 33 months, you can apply for the settlement permit, and become a permanent resident of Germany.
- If you live and work in Germany for eight years, you can even apply for German citizenship.
- Your immediate family members can come with you, and they are allowed to work and study in Germany as well.
- You can travel to other EU countries for up to three months within a six-month period.
- After 18 months, you can apply for a Blue Card for another country.
